Vision:

The Vision of the Education Service Commission is to see “**quality education delivered by efficient and effective education service personnel**”.

Mandate:

The mandate of the Education Service Commission is to: **advise the President in performing his/her functions in relation to Article 172 of the Constitution and on appointing all personnel in the education service and charged with developing, maintaining and improving the quality of those personnel and that of the service generally.**

Mission Statement:

The Mission Statement of the Education Service Commission is “**to provide professional and competent Education service personnel**”

Key Functions of the Commission:

The functions of the Commission are derived from its mandate and they include among others:

- i) To advise the President in performing his functions in relation to the education service under Article 172 of the Constitution.
- ii) To appoint persons to hold or act in any office in the Education service including the power to confirm such appointments, to exercise disciplinary control over such persons and to remove them from office.
- iii) To review the terms and conditions of service, standing Orders, training and qualifications of public officers in supervision and technical.
- iii) To guide District Service Commission, to ensure conformity to national standards within the sector.
