



# **EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

The Belgian Development Agency (BTC) and the Ministry of Health are recruiting health experts to work as Technical Advisors in the two regions of Rwenzori and Westnile.

## NATIONAL TECHNICAL ASSISTANT (HEALTH FINANCING)

The National Technical Assistant Health Financing will be responsible for the Results Based Financing aspects at implementation level for both the Private Not For Profit project (PNFP) and the Institutional Capacity Building Phase II project (ICB II) of the Belgian Agency for Development (BTC).

He/she will work hand in hand with the National Technical Assistant at MoH level (NTA central) and the National Technical Assistant Health System Strengthening in the region. The 2 NTAs in the region will function under a common plan to assure optimal coordination and division of labour within the team.

He/she will respond hierarchically to the project manager and International Technical Advisors of both BTC projects.

#### Responsibilities and tasks:

- Guide all project activities assigned to him/her according to the joint planning
- Coordinate the implementation and monitoring of all district activities in the region related to Results Based Financing for the PNFP and ICB II project
- o Advice DMHT and DHO office in their work related to the Results Based Financing (RBF) implementation
- Monitor the implementation of the RBF manual of procedure, including RBF scheme and RBF tools (information system, monitoring and evaluation, fiduciary system, contracts, business plans, etc.)
- Ensure that District Health Management Teams (DHMT) support, follow-up and control Public and Private-Not-For-Profit (PNFP) health facility business plans, financial reports and health services performance reports
- Support the DHMT in the organization of evaluation activities and participate in the joint meetings between District Health Office (DHO) and PNFP coordination bodies
- Represent BTC as team member for selection of RBF beneficiaries and the accreditation procedure
- o Represent BTC as a team member for the verification of the PNFP health facilities' performance

- o Actively communicate on RBF and conduct advocacy Other Clir
- Assure the development of business plans and e-patient files by Health Centre IV and General Hospitals
- Support DHMT in costing exercises and comparative costing studies between hospitals for both the public and PNFP sector
- Contribute to the reflection on the financing mechanisms for the emergency evacuation system
- Organise the M&E system and assure the quantitative data collection
- Ensure the monitoring of the project activities and results and submit quarterly reports to the national level, including the lessons learned in the RBF implementation process
