



ELECTORAL COMMISSION

What do I need as a voter on polling day?

- a. Present yourself to the polling station where you are registered as a voter;
- b. Present your voter identification documents (this could be your national identity card, or your voter location slip);
- c. If you do not have any of the above, you can still be assisted by the Presiding Officer to check and confirm your particulars on the National Voters Register;
- d. The Presiding Officer will authenticate your identity using the biometric voter verification machine;
- e. After verification, you will be issued with a ballot paper;
- f. Proceed to the basin and mark the candidate of your choice, using either the tick or the thumbprint;
- g. Fold the ballot paper lengthwise as shown by the Presiding Officer;
- h. Proceed to the ballot box and carefully insert the ballot paper;
- i. The Polling Assistant will mark the cuticle of your finger to indicate that you have voted;
- j. Please note that the polling station opens at 7:00am in the morning and closes at 4:00pm in the evening. Please get to your polling station in time to vote!
- k. Exercise your right to choose your leaders;
