Background

KOPGT provides long term reliable support to small scale oil palm farmers and out growers scheme on Bugala and outlying islands in Kalangala District.

JOB TITLE : DATA OFFICER (DO)

REPORTS TO : CREDIT MANAGER (CM)

MAIN PURPOSE:

The main purpose of this position is to support effective functionality of IT systems and provision of IT related services and other communications on IT platforms. It may also include performing data entry work as part of a larger data processing required for the smooth running of operations of KOPGT.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Continuous development of short term and long-term IT strategy of KOPGT
- 2. Provision of technical and operational advice to other members of staff in working with IT dependent systems such as the finance systems
- 3. Design data collection tools and entry screens
- 4. Provide trouble shooting services
- 5. Design, manage and maintain KOPGT website
- 6. Identification and prioritisation of IT needs on an annual basis
- 7. Providing software support to staff including requests, and installation
- 8. Organizes documents; prepares and codes data for entry into computer system.
- 9. Enters data into system via on-line terminals and other data entry devices; verifies for accuracy and completeness.

Job Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree in Information Technology, computer science, statistics or quantitative economics
- Working experience of at least three (3) years in a similar function

JOB TITLE : FRESH FRUIT BUNCHES QUALITY INSPECTOR (FFBQI)

REPORTS TO : FIELD OPERATIONS MANAGER (FOM)

Main Purpose:

The overall purpose of this position is to ensure that all requirements relating to compliance and quality of oil palm fresh fruit bunches (FFB) are met.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Execute quality checks on FFB and suitability for transportation to the factory
- 2. Strict adherence to FFB testing and sampling regime
- 3. Promoting quality procedures and continuous improvement in the quality of FFB
- 4. Physically inspecting FFB

- Ensure FFB delivered to OPUL in high quality
- Improved quality of FFBs
- Quality assurance and quality control procedures

Person's Specification

- A minimum of a Diploma in Agriculture from a recognised institution.
- A degree in agriculture related field is an added advantage.
- Experience of not less than three (3) years in quality inspection; preferably in plantation agriculture.
- Computer literate in Micro soft office suite packages.
