LivingStone is a young University but growing and advancing. LIU was granted a letter of interim authority by Uganda's National Council of Higher Education to begin operation in 2008. In March 2010, after rigorous inspections and interviews, a provisional license was granted which authorized LIU to admit students beginning January 16, 2012 on a campus in Mbale. Since January of 2012 LIU has admitted five additional classes of students with students from ten nations. We now have five programs from which students may study: Business Administration, IT, Media, Christian Ministry and Education. We plan to add more programs to enhance the students' vocational abilities to find

employment and excel in their chosen professions. We would particularly like to add programs in the area of the Sciences.

The groundbreaking for the new campus of Livingstone International University is a major accomplishment of a great vision started a decade ago. The early founders of Livingstone began with a vision for a Christian University in the Mbale area that would serve Eastern Uganda specifically but also the whole of Uganda. As they began to plan, they purchased this land on which we are standing today, 50 acres with the hope of expanding as the University grows. The founders have been looking forward to seeing new buildings being constructed that will house LIU for many years to come.

As we look around us today and see the beginnings of preparing the site for construction, we can see another goal of the vision coming in focus and another step in fulfilling that earlier vision. In a couple of months, the foundations will be ready and we will lay the first cornerstone. This will be another important milestone in the expansion of LIU, and we will celebrate that event with stakeholders as we lay the first cornerstone.
