



REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FOR THE PROVISION OF INCINERATION AND RECYCLING SERVICES FOR WASTES FOR THE YEARS 2020 up to 2022

The PMI VectorLink Uganda Project is funded by USAID under the US President's Malaria Initiative (PMI) with the goal of reducing the burden of malaria in the country. This project works closely with Ministry of Health and currently conducts Indoor Residual Spraying (IRS) in 16 districts of Uganda namely; Alebtong, Amolatar, Budaka, Butebo, Butaleja, Dokolo, Namutumba, Pallisa, Bugiri, Kaberamaido, Kalaki, Kibuku, Lira, Otuke, Serere, and Tororo.

We call upon experienced and reputable companies with required capacity for treatment, incineration recycling and final disposal of wastes to submit bids for provision of the named services. The IRS generated wastes shall be handled in a safe and environmentally friendly manner in line with waste management regulations and available best practices. These wastes shall include but not be limited to;

Lot 1. Assorted plastics namely HDPE, LDPE, PET, PVC, nitrile and neoprene. These could come in form of bottles, buckets, jugs, basins, Jerry cans, gloves, helmets, gumboots and the like.

Lot 2. Paper waste of various categories

Lot 3. Fabric, cushions, nose and mouth masks (N95, EN 149), aerosol cans, batteries of various sizes (12v 200 AH, 6v 12AH, AAA, AA, Cell D) and any other IRS contaminated solid wastes.

Eligibility

- Firms interested in incineration, treatment and landfilling MUST have a valid license to own/operate a treatment and disposal facility by the National Environmental Management Authority (NEMA)
- Firms interested in recycling MUST have a valid license to operate and recycle
- Wastes shall be transported from the different sites and secured. Applicable NEMA licenses for transportation of wastes shall apply and recycled materials shall not be used for food related items.

Expressions of Interest must include the following minimum documentation:

- How you intend to manage the wastes of interest; listing methods to be employed including final handling of residues, by-products and the names thereof. Indicate measures in place for pollution control and monitoring.
- Safety and environment policies in place.
- Copies of registration documents, waste management history and NEMA valid licenses
- Names & addresses of previous clients.
- Willingness for facilities to be inspected by the client prior to and post award on management of clients waste

All proposals MUST be submitted in a sealed envelope by close of business (4:00PM) on Thursday May 21, 2020 to either of the following addresses:
