Overall Responsibility

In close collaboration with the Deputy Chief of Party (DCOP), and NTLP Program Manager, the MDR-TB Technical Advisor will be responsible for providing targeted technical assistance to all clinical TB, and MDR-TB activities for the project. The Technical Advisor (a senior clinician) will also be responsible for providing technical support to health facilities offering TB and MDR-TB care services. S/he will work closely with Programme Manager NTLP, the MDR Coordinator and members of multidisciplinary teams to ensure efficiency and effectiveness of interventions implemented for control of MDR in the country. In addition s/he will collaborate with the Data Manager/Monitoring & Evaluation Officer to regularly monitor the progress made towards the targets for programmatic management of drug resistant TB.

Qualifications

1) An MBCHB degree with masters training in internal medicine (MMED) or Public (MPH) or both 2) Minimum of six years practical experience working in a TB related field is essential 3) Recognized expertise in TB, MDR-TB programming, at country level is essential 4) Demonstrated clear understanding of current key TB, TB/HIV control and MDR-TB issues at national and global level 5) Proven ability to build strong relationships, work well as part of a team, and to incorporate views of other disciplines into his or her work 6) Demonstrated organizational and supervisory skills and abilities; sound judgment, and high ethical standards; flexible and able to adapt to changing priorities and deadlines
