Bishop Stuart University is a not-for-profit Chartered educational institution established by Ankole Diocese of the Province of the Anglican Church of Uganda to provide Christian based higher Education, training and research for the expansion of God's Kingdom, human Knowledge and betterment of society.

The University has its main campus at Kakoba, Mbarara Municipality, Mbarara District in Uganda and another Campus at Ruharo, near St. James Cathedral, the headquarters of Ankole Diocese.

STUDENTS' LIFE

Accommodation: The University offers Accommodations to only Nursing Science Students. The rest of students sleep in privately owned hostels. However, students are encouraged to stay in Hostels that are accredited by the University.
