



GEMS student shines at South Africa Level 3 Regional Age Group Championships 2018

During the spring break, Darren Ssamula (Year 10 student) was in Cape Town competing at the Level 3 Regional Age Group Championships. Darren participated in the competition alongside 7 other Dolphin Swim Club Kampala members.

Darren, who was among the top 5 in most of the events left a lasting impression, pocketing 3 silver and 1 bronze medal in the three-day championship.

The competition attracted 43 clubs from South Africa, Namibia and Uganda - all of them looking to swim their way to titles and medals the Championship events.

Darren won silver in the 200 IM and 400m freestyle, bronze in 200m freestyle and was placed 4th in the 100M free-style. He was among one of the fastest swimmers in the 50 breaststroke and 4x50 and 4x100 free-style relay events.

Darren Ssamula also bagged 7 medals in the Kenya Swimming Federation Long Course National Age Group and Open Championship in February.
