A brief of ongoing activities for all the WSDFs as at 31st December 2015

Urban Water Supply and Sewerage Department (Ministry of Water and Environment) is developing piped water supply systems and sanitation facilities in small towns (STs) and Rural Growth Centres (RGCs) across the whole country. The funding for these town projects is by the Government of Uganda (GoU) with support from the Germany Development Bank (KfW), the African Development Bank (AfDB), the European Union (EU) and the Austrian Development Agency (ADA).
