According to the IRA, gross claims for both life and non-life insurance rose by 16.08 %.from sh184.3b in 2014 to sh214b in 2015, what does this mean to both the customers and the insurance companies? The industry has since had new players, recent unfavourable weather conditions increasing crop failure as a result of drought. As such more claims are being reported and paid increasing customer

How much was paid in life claims in 2015? Out of this, what was Liberty's contribution?

Life gross claims paid increased from UGX18 billion in 2014 to UGX25 billion in 2015. IN 2015, Liberty Life Uganda paid claims to the tune of UGX11,776,770,000= that is 65% of the Life claims Over the years the insurance industry has suffered negativity over claims settlements, which has in turn eroded public confidence in the sector. What efforts are in place to revive this confidence? A vibrant regulator who ensures that industry players adhere to the rules and regulations. Also the introduction of cover extensions like Political violence & Terrorism has provided extra cover to customers which wasn't the norm. More sensitization of customers on the benefits and products of insurance is happening now and this should drive consumer choice.

In your opinion, what are the key issues to consider in laying a claim and what must be followed and how? Establish whether

the claim is payable and communicated promptly. Submission of all the necessary claim supporting documentation; filling the claim form, Police report and other documents pertaining to the claim, if any.

The year is almost gone, and looking at the economy, how has it affected claims in the industry and what is your prediction for next year? Poor economic performance

next year? Poor economic performance affects money in circulation thus affecting premium remittances which adversely affects claims settlement. For covers like credit life and unemployment benefits, this increases delinquency and reduces borrowing affecting industry growth.
