In 2004, the Brothers of Christian Instruction Uganda Province in cooperation with Uganda Martyrs University (UMU) began an affiliate University College on the Kisubi Campus at Mount St. Teresa.

On 27th March 2009, National Council for Higher Education authorized the Kisubi Brothers Centre of UMU to become a Constituent College of Uganda Martyrs University, known as Kisubi Brothers University College (KBUC).

On 29th June 2015, the National Council for Higher Education (NCHC) granted an independent operational license to the University in its new name, University of Kisubi (UniK).
