The Board, Management and Staff of Rural Electrification Agency Congratulate the European Union in celebrating the Europe day and 40 years of European Union in Uganda.

The European Union through the German Development Bank (kfW), have extended funds 14.7 million which will go towards the implementation of power evacuation projects in Kasese and Bundibugyo.

The European Union has also funded Output Based Aid (OBA) which has improved access to electricity to poor households throughout Uganda. The Project subsidizes the full cost of connections to poor households within the low voltage network. Those eligible are persons who need a no pole service and are able to pay for internal house wiring and the energy consumed but have not connected.

The project has so far connected 102,017 Ugandan rural households out of the targeted 115,700 connections, to be achieved by project closure June 2017.
