## 2017 COURSES INTAKE

The Islamic University in Uganda (IUIU) is an International University established in 1988 by the Organization of the Islamic Cooperation (OIC). It is the ONLY University in Uganda established under the Act of Parliament of Uganda Cap. 131, and under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. In regard to the 2017/2018 academic year, the office of the Academic Registrar wishes to invite applicants for the following Programmes offered at its campuses namely: Main Campus Mbale, Females' Campus, Kabojja, Kampala Campus, Kibuli and Arua Campus, Arua. Please note that IUIU introduced April intake in addition to the usual January & August intakes. The Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery (Extensors) usually start in May whereas Certificates in Nursing and Midwifery period starts in November. Admissions of all these programmes are in progress;
