Qualifications:

Master's degree in international development, agriculture, economics, public health, nutrition, or related field of study or equivalent experience or ten (10) years of experience and Bachelors. Five (5) or more years of progressively responsible work experience in managing or implementing development programs.

Master's degree in business administration, finance, management or relevant field. Minimum of five (5) years of progressively responsible experience in professional financial analysis, accounting or auditing, preferably with an international organization or accounting firm. Familiarization and on-the-job training on US Government accounting and USAID Financial management.
