Entry Requirements Direct Entry

For Direct Entry a candidate will have:

- Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) with at least 5credits of which one must be English or its equivalent.
- At least 2 principal passes in relevant subjects at A 'level Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) or its equivalent.

Diploma Entry

Candidates will be admitted if they have at least a second class diploma award from a recognized institution of Higher learning.

Diploma Applicants.

A candidate must have obtained at least one principal pass at A 'level (UACE) or a certificate from a recognized Tertiary or Institution of learning.

International Students.

The equivalent of required documents shall be accepted from a recognized institution of the candidate's country of origin

NB: Completed applications must be accompanied with photocopies of academic certificates, transcripts plus four passport size photographs.
